From 2005 to 2008, Ms Sakdiah held different jobs ranging from cleaner to odd-job labourer. However, all these jobs required long working hours and due to her ailing health and weak eyesight, Ms Sakdiah was forced to quit. Without income, she survived on plain rice and instant noodles every day.



Ms Sakdiah was recently admitted to St Luke's Hospital (SLH) for wound care treatment and rehabilitation. In the beginning, she was worried that she could not afford the hefty medical bills, but when St Luke's medical social worker learnt about it, financial assistance was provided to Ms Sakdiah through the hospital's Patient's Welfare Fund (PWF). Under this PWF scheme, Ms Sakdiah will not need to worry about the cost of her follow-up visits to SLH after her discharge.
